1. To receive a waiver to practice opioid dependency treatment with approved buprenorphine medications a physician must notify the SAMHSA Center for Substance Abuse Treatment (CSAT) of their intent to practice this form of medication assisted treatment (MAT). Under the Drug Addiction Treatment Act of 2000 (DATA 2000), physicians are required an 8 hours buprenorphine waiver training course in order to prescribe and/or dispense buprenorphine. The following SAMHSA-supported continuing medical education (CME) courses can help physicians qualify to prescribe buprenorphine in an office setting.

- American Psychiatric Association
- Buprenorphine Waiver Training at the American Academy of Addiction Psychiatry
- DATA 2000 Qualifying Buprenorphine Training at the American Society of Addiction Medicine

2. Physicians can be reimbursed for training course (upon valid receipt).

3. In order to get credential at New Horizons Medical, P.C. physician must have Training Course done and Buprenorphine Waiver done (buprenorphine controlled substance number from DEA). Once above is done, then Credentialing will be done prior to begin working at our clinic. Timeline is upon Physician's cooperation with above and paperwork needed for Credentialing purposes.
